Percentage of students who graduate within 4 years and a summer with a regular diploma.



#### **Economically Disadvantaged**

The percentage of students from families that meet eligibility criteria for economically disadvantaged subgroup.



#### **English Language Learners**

Percentage of students whose first language is not English and qualify for services related to English as a second language.



#### **Students with Disabilities**

The percentage of students who qualify to receive special education services.



#### **Teachers + Ratio to Students**

## **TENNESSEE PROMISE - TNPROMISE.GOV**

Beginning with the class of 2015, all students in the state of Tennessee can attend (for FREE) one of the state's 13 community colleges, 27 colleges of applied technology, or other eligible institution offering an associate's degree program. Tennessee Promise provides students a last-dollar scholarship that will cover tuition and fees not covered by the Pell grant, the HOPE scholarship, or state student assistance funds. Students are also assigned a mentor to help guide them, are required to complete just 8 hours of community service per term enrolled and maintain at least a 2.0 GPA.
